Loco Pilot Instruction No.11/2025

Sub: Actionable points to be followed by crew.

- While on duty, if you are travelling as spare, please ensure your CUG phone remains switched ON.
- 2. Whenever relieved en-route, immediately inform the on-duty CCOR(Control) and follow the instructions.
- If you use CUG phone during duty hours, make sure to record the details in the CUG register kept in the lobby at the time of sign-off.
- 4. In case of any delay of the train at a station or within station section due to any reason ,promptly inform the TLC.
- 5. The Assistant Loco Pilot must repeat the status on the upcoming caution order, which is applicable in the next block section, before crossing the previous station/section and ensure that the Loco Pilot is duly informed and if no caution available in next block section must convey "NIL caution order " to LP. Additionally, the caution order must be repeatedly reminded when the train is about 3 km away from the caution location till reaching the location, and close attention must be paid to the speed.

If, for any reason , the Loco Pilot fails to comply with the prescribed speed the RS valve must be operated immediately.
